Fish Welfare

In line with the increasing concerns about fish welfare Harwich Angling Club would like to highlight key aspects to improve the handling of your catch.

- 1. Use only barbless hooks
- 2. No bolt/fixed rigs.
- 3. A large wet unhooking mat for larger fish, i.e. bream/carp. Ideally a mat with edges to prevent fish leaving the mat or a suitable cradle.
- 4. Landing net of appropriate size to be used when landing any sizeable fish. 42 inches plus for carp fishing.
- 5. Disgorger of appropriate type for removal of hooks.
- 6. When landing sizeable fish, it is preferred practice to not swing in fish, but use a landing net, unhook fish in net and return to the water from landing net.
- 7. If handling fish wet hands do less damage and on no account handle with a cloth.
- 8. Fish are not to be retained/sacked for extended periods of time/overnight, this practice is only permitted whilst setting up camera equipment, fish are to be released after photographing.
